<p>Purpose of Form</p> <p>Use Form NH-1310 to claim a refund on behalf of a deceased taxpayer.</p> <p>Who Must File</p> <p>If you are claiming a refund on behalf of a deceased taxpayer, you must file Form NH-1310.</p> <p>Line A</p> <p>Check the box on Line A when filing a return requesting a refund in your name and your deceased spouse's name or if you received a refund check in your name and your deceased spouse's name. Please return the joint-name check with a completed Form NH-1310 to the address provided on the form. A new check will be issued in your name and mailed to you.</p>	<p>Line B</p> <p>Check the box on Line B only if you are the decedent's court-appointed administrator or executor. You must include a copy of the court certificate showing your appointment with the completed Form NH-1310. A copy of the decedent's will cannot be accepted as evidence that you are the personal representative.</p> <p>Line C</p> <p>Check the box on Line C if Line A or Line B above are not applicable. Include a copy of the death certificate with the completed Form NH-1310 and a check will be issued to the estate of the deceased and will be mailed to the claimant identified at the top of the form.</p>
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
